Double distilled and double matured in 100% bourbon casks and new oak barrels from the forest in the Lorraine area. A single malt, single cask French whisky, made from malted barley only, very aromatic peaty whisky with a strong finish. The Grallet-Dupic Distillery has been producing exceptional spirits since 1860, inspired by the magnificent nature of the Lorraine region in France

#### **Color**

straw-yellow

#### **Aroma**

Vanilla, peat and wood.

#### **Taste**

Fine and elegant with a peaty flavor, perfectly blended with cereal notes, followed by vanilla, ripe fruit and wood hints. The palate is slightly mineral.

#### **Finish**

Long and persistent.

The Grallet-Dupic Whisky Distillery The Grallet-Dupic Distillery was founded in 1860 by Hubert Grallet in Rozelieures, a small town of only 160 inhabitants. Inspired by the Lorraine region's nature and ideal conditions for the production of fine whisky. The distillery uses locally grown barley for their peaty malts, their whiskeys are double distilled in Charentais pot stills and aged in a variety of casks from different parts of the world.
